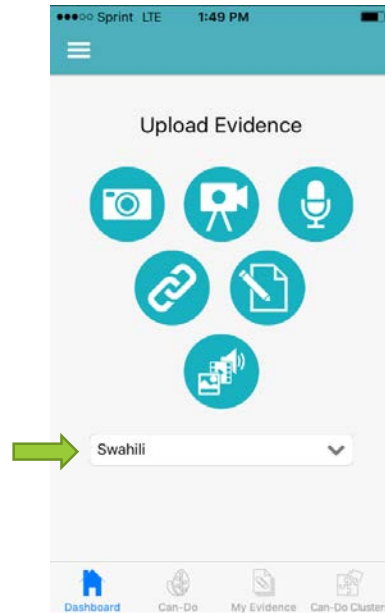

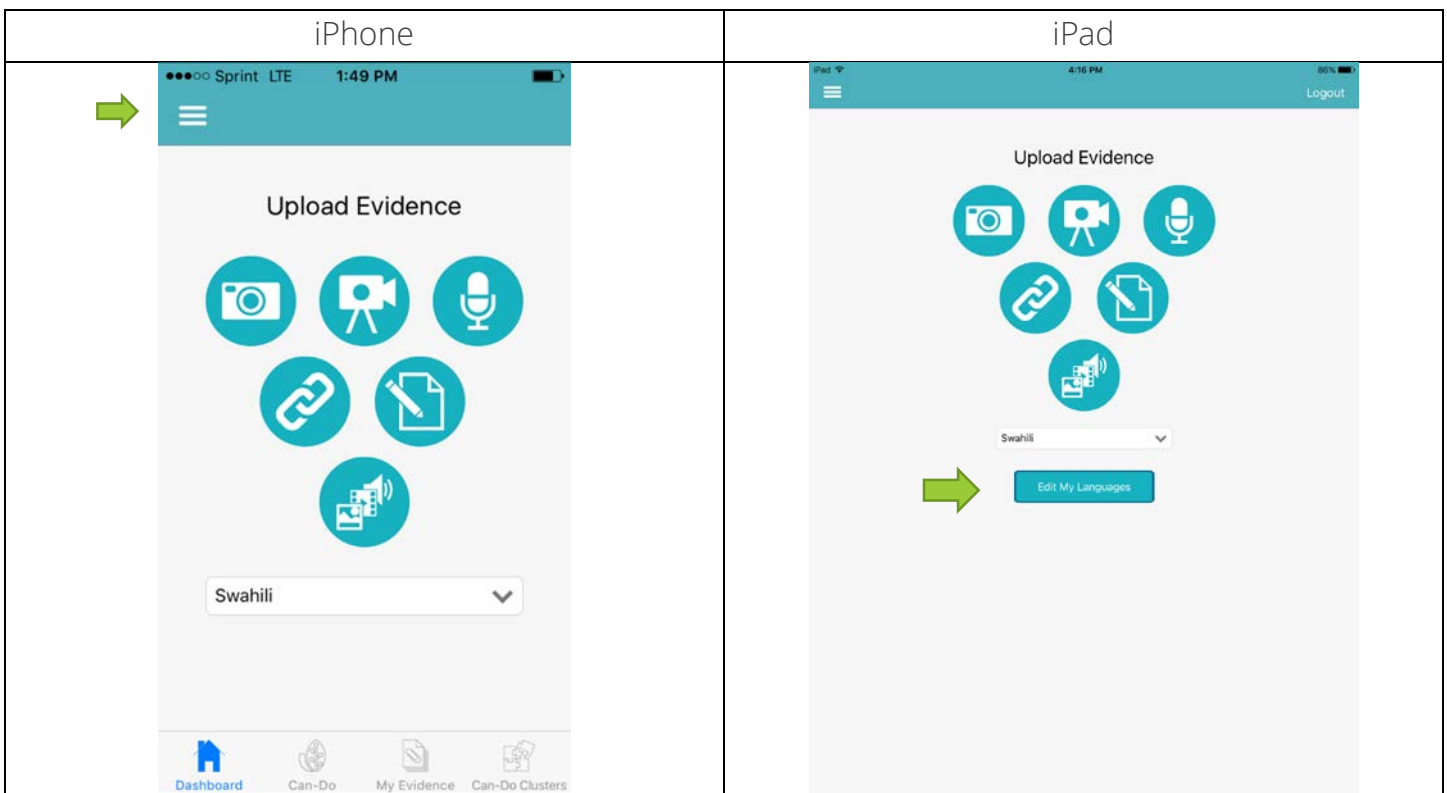
Student Tutorial: Adding a Language Using *ST LFO to Go*

This tutorial provides students an overview of how to add a language using *ST LFO to Go*.

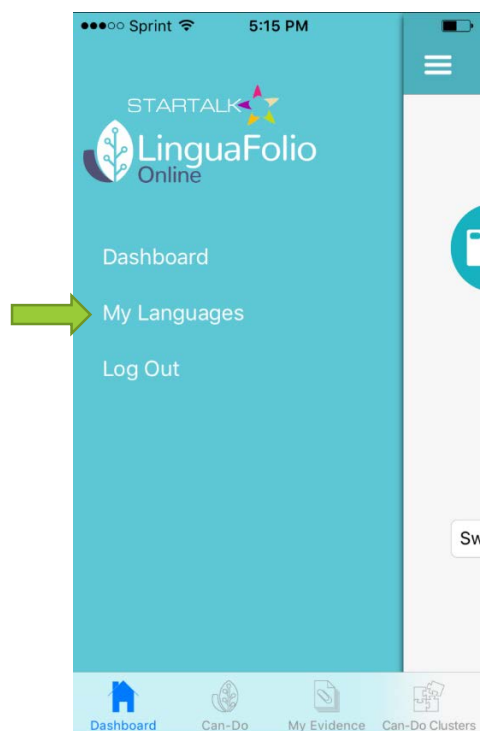
1. Once you log in, you will see your dashboard. If you already selected a language when you set up your account, it will appear in the dropdown menu in the center of the screen.



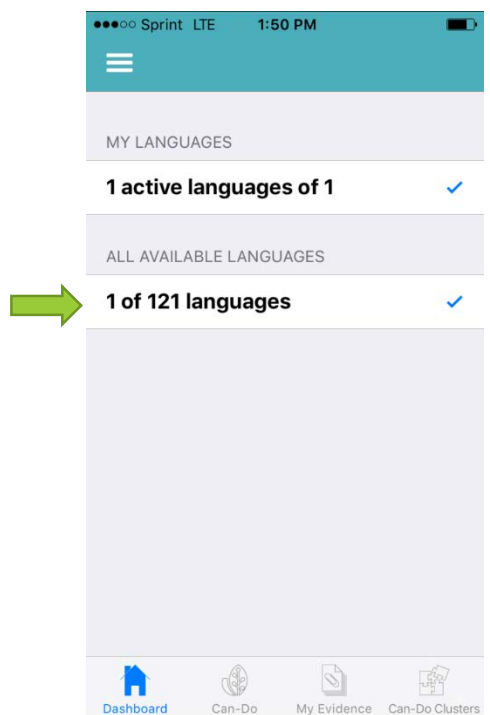
2. If you want to add a language, tap the menu in the top left corner on the iPhone. Tap “Edit My Languages” on the iPad.



3. Next, tap "My Languages" on the iPhone. Skip this step on the iPad.



4. You will then see a language menu. If you want to see what languages you already selected, tap the bar under "My Languages." To add a language, tap the bar underneath "All Available Languages."



5. Next, find and tap the language(s) you want to add. The STARTALK languages and most commonly chosen languages are listed first. The rest are listed in alphabetical order. You may add multiple languages, but will have to wait for each one to update before tapping the next choice.
