- 1. Based on existing research, what is the minimum number of times that your students should upload evidence to Pulsar?
- a. One time
- b. Two times
- c. Three times
- d. Four times

Feedback: The correct answer is D. Research suggests a tipping point of sorts with language learning portfolios. At and beyond four interactions, gains related to improved task value, self-regulated learning, and perceived value of portfolios are all observed. These benefits were not observed at three or less interactions, and students believed the portfolios to be superfluous.

- 2. What are some ways to facilitate efficient evidence capture and upload?
- a. Use a naming convention for files that are saved to shared locations.
- b. If possible, use an aide or other helper so that learners can rotate in and out of the lab.
- c. Give learners 20-30 minutes to explore the platform at the beginning of the program.
- d. Communicate the specific Can-Do Statements that your learners should have evidence for before they begin uploading.
- e. All of the above.

The correct answer is E. Learners need to be able to easily access their files, be aware of which Can-Do Statements their files connect to, and have familiarity with the platform before upload. Plus, another set of hands to help never hurt!

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
